Mission Search Installation Instructions

1 What you'll need

- Microsoft® Windows® 10
- 63MB of disk space
- Personalized license file (signature.lic)

2 Local or Remote installation?

Identify the machine on which the Mission Search application will be installed. If this machine has a connection to the Internet, follow the “Remote” instructions below. If the machine is not connected to the Internet, follow the “Local” instructions below.

2.1 Local

2.1.1 Download

From a machine connected to the Internet, download “MissionSearchInstall_l.zip” from the following link:

2.1.2 Transfer and Extract

Transfer this file to the machine on which the Mission Search application will be installed and extract all files in the zip.

2.1.3 Kick off the Installation

On the machine selected for installation, in the “Mission Search Local Install” folder, double-click “MissionSearchSetup_l.exe”. Skip to section 3 Install.

2.2 Remote

2.2.1 Download

Download “MissionSearchSetup_r.exe” from the following link:


2.2.2 Kick off the Installation

On the machine selected for installation, double-click “MissionSearchSetup_r.exe”.

3 Install

3.1 Pre-requisites


If prompted to install the Visual C++ "14" Runtime Libraries (x64), select "Install". Please note that a reboot may be required.



3.2 Mission Search


3.2.1 Security Warning

If prompted that the publisher could not be verified (may occur during remote installation), select "Run".




3.2.2 Installation Wizard

Click through the setup wizard to install the application.




After the software is installed, click “Close” on the last step of the setup wizard.



3.2.3 Licensing


Double-click on the desktop shortcut for the Mission Search application.

When prompted to load a license file, click “Yes”.



Select the “signature.lic” file that you received from Mission Control Systems.

When a valid license is loaded, the application will open and be ready for your first search.
